Northaven, a retirement home for the elderly is the outgrowth of the concern of the congregation of Olympic View Community Church of which The Reverend Mays is pastor.



Construction Begins

"Northaven is a relatively large undertaking for a small suburban church... the Reverend Robert Mays, pastor, and the congregation felt a strong need to better serve the growing segment of elderly in the community who are living on a limited, fixed income."



Northaven is 50 years old.

Northaven was the vision of Rev. Bob Mays of Olympic View Community Church of the Brethren. A group of families from the church mortgaged their homes as collateral for a HUD loan. Because of their courage and vision, Northaven has been a home to seniors in need of affordable housing since its very founding.

Later, Northaven added Assisted Living, which is now 40 years old.

We added 82 new affordable senior housing units, opened this year in partnership with HumanGood.





There are 80 solar panels on the roof of our new residence.

Executive Director Darlene Storti has worked at Northaven for 36 years.

There have only been four executive directors: Rev. Ralph Turnidge, Norma Murphy, Sandi Keuss and Darlene Storti.






Rosa Hernandez has worked at Northaven for 21 years.

She began in the kitchen, then moved to housekeeping, and is now housekeeping manager. Her first-generation American daughter recently graduated from college and is now a member of our Board of Trustees.

Anthony Freeman has worked at Northaven 35 years, starting in the kitchen, then joining the maintenance crew and also helping as an escort on bus trips. Anthony has missed ONE day of work in all those years.





Martha Kelley, who has lived at Northaven for 13 years, celebrated her 100th birthday.

Martha was born in Michigan but has lived in many places. She moved to Seattle in 1999, to be near her daughter and her family. She has another daughter in Hawaii. Bridge is Martha's passion. "I have played Bridge from coast to coast, starting when I was 21." She still meets with three other residents every Monday and Friday to play.

99-year-old Jeanne Hayden has lived at Northaven for 26 years.



Jeanne and her family moved to Seattle from Spokane in 1965 and raised four children. She started making quilts in 1986 and joined a group of quilters at United Presbyterian Church.

She has sewn over 1,000 quilts, most going to Children's Hospital.

She has also crocheted hundreds of caps for homeless people. She has always liked color, and you can see it in her clothes and the famous hats she wears. "I had over a dozen, more than shoes, but am down to four now that I have moved into a smaller Assisted Living space," she says. She is losing her sight but refuses to fret or worry about it. "I take every day one at a time," she says. "God is taking care of me."
